Big Data Analytics

Streaming data, social media data, content, electronic medical records, astronomy surveys, genomic and proteomic studies result into repositories of terabytes/petabytes/exabytes scale and pose significant challenges in analysis, which can be transformed to opportunities in Data Science. Recent meetings (KDCloud10, KDCloud11, and PDAC10) have generated interest in adopting cloud and distributed computing resources for large scale data management, data mining and knowledge discovery tasks.

The First International Conference on Big Data Analytics (BDA 2012) is set in this backdrop. The goal of the conference is to generate interest among researchers by exposing them to ground breaking opportunities that arise during analysis and processing of massive volumes of distributed data stored across clusters of networked computers. We invite researchers, developers, and users to participate in this event to share and discuss the emerging challenges in developing data management and data mining solutions, and frameworks around cloud and distributed computing platforms.
