- White garbage bags containing 25% of Carbonic Acid Calcium.
[700mm (length) × 500mm (width) / 30 liter].
- Plastic shopping bags containing 25% of Carbonic Acid Calcium (It will be marked on bags).

燃やせるごみ / Burnable Garbage

To throw away burnable garbage such as ...

<p>Egg containers, shells, aluminum foil, paper boxes covered with aluminum foil, cooking oil containers, ketchup or other sauce bottles, shampoo, detergent, & bleaching containers, icing, medical ice packs, leather items, video & cassette tapes, Hokkairo (one time use body warmer), toilet sand for pets, and styrene foams.</p>	<p>A. Please <u>put them into designated garbage bag</u>, and throw them away as burnable trash.</p>

Q. How should I dispose of...

Answers

<p>Used cooking oil</p>	<p>Please <u>harden the oil with coagulant or soak it up into newspaper</u> and throw away as burnable trash. You can also <u>use a chemical and recycle as soil</u>.</p>
<p>Bags (except designated trash bags)</p>	<p>Please <u>don't use them as trash bags!</u> Please throw plastic bags away in small quantities as burnable trash.</p>
<p>Garden tree cuttings</p>	<p>Please <u>cut branches down into no longer than 60 cm in length and make bundles of 60(length) × 30(diameter)</u>, and throw them away as burnable garbage.</p>
<p>Garden waste and grasses</p>	<p><u>If you can, please compost them.</u> But if that is impossible, please bundle or pack them and throw away as burnable garbage.</p>
<p>Wood</p>	<p>Please <u>make bundles of wood less than 60cm in length and 10cm in diameter</u>, and throw them away as burnable trash.</p>
<p>Wood furniture</p>	<p><u>If possible, break it into 60cm lengths</u> and please throw away as burnable trash. <u>Larger items should be disposed as over sized rubbish.</u></p>
<p>Electric carpet</p>	<p>Please <u>throw away foldable items of less than 60cm as burnable trash</u> and <u>larger items as oversized rubbish.</u> Cords should be thrown away as un-burnable trash.</p>
<p>Electric blankets</p>	<p>Please throw away as burnable trash.</p>

Futons (Japanese styles sleeping mattress)	Please <u>tie the futon into a bundle</u> . Then throw it away as burnable trash.
Bedding and mattresses containing magnets	Please <u>separate bedding into burnable (no magnet) and un-burnable (magnet) portions</u> . <u>If the bed cannot be separated</u> like this, please <u>put it out as burnable rubbish</u> .

To throw away un-burnable garbage such as ...

Cosmetic bottles, gas stoves, gas stove protection cover, ski and ski boots, child seats, children's tricycles, electric kotatsu (heating-table) & kotatsu plate, snow shovels, polyurethane tanks, word processors, portable toilets, plastic tire chains.	A. Please throw them away as un-burnable trash.

Q. How should I dispose of...

Answers

Breakable (glass, panes of glass, pottery, etc..) and cutlery items(cooking or cutting knife, razors, etc..) ?	Please <u>wrap them in newspaper etc.</u> and throw away as un-burnable trash.
Oil heaters & fan heaters	Please <u>completely drain the remaining oil and throw away as un-burnable garbage</u> . If it uses a battery (dry cell battery, etc.), please remove it too. See page 4 for disposing of batteries.
Corrugated tin	<u>Roll and bind the sheets of tin and throw away as un-burnable trash.</u>
Wire	<u>Roll up and throw it away as un-burnable trash.</u>
Cigarette lighters	Please throw away as un-burnable trash <u>after extracting the gas.</u>
Cans that contained engine oil, paint cans, & oil cans	Please <u>drain all the oil from the can and throw away as un-burnable trash.</u> ※Ask a gas station about the disposal of engine oil.
Spray cans & Gas cans used for a portable cooking stove	Please <u>use up all gases inside the bottle and make a hole to release air from it.</u> Then throw the empty bottle away as un-burnable trash. When you make a hole in the can, please air the room well.

Bicycles, Motor-bikes (under 125cc), Furniture type Kotatsus, FF-type heaters (FF:Forced draft balanced flow)	They are oversized garbage, so please contact <u>Haikibutsu Taisaku-ka</u> for disposal. (See page 8 for applying.)
Dry cell batteries	Please take them to the ^{Kandenchi} <u>乾電池 collection box</u> set in citizens' centers, community centers, city hall, or Chuo Komin-kan (public hall).
Button type dry cell batteries	Please consult the shop.
Tires & Tire wheels	Please separate tires & wheels and throw both away as <u>un-burnable trash</u> . Tires should be less than 30cm in width and 75cm in diameter. (See page 9 for more details.)
Studded (Spike) Tires	When you throw away a studded tire, please <u>pull out studs (pins) before disposing it</u> .

かん類 / Cans

Q. How should I dispose of...

Answers

Beverage cans	Please <u>rinse inside of the cans and recycle them as either スチール (steels) or アルミニウム (aluminums)</u> . Please check for the recycling marks on the cans.
Cans with no indication of steel or aluminum	Please recycle those items <u>with "steel" cans</u> . The cans should be about to powdered milk can size.
Tea cans & Tinned food cans	<u>Rinse inside of the cans well, and put them in the "steel" recycling box.</u>
Cans which remain stains after rinsing, Tinned food cans' cover, Cookie tins, Sweets boxes, Cans left on the road, and Bottle-can caps.	Please throw away as un-burnable trash.
What should I do if there is something in the can such as a cigarette butt, etc.?	<u>Remove everything from inside cans and rinse them first, then put them into a recycle bin. If you cannot remove an object from the can, please throw it away as un-burnable trash.</u>

ペットボトル／Pet Bottles

Pet bottles Please separate bottles and bottle tops, and rinse inside the bottle. Then, put them into the recycle box. (If possible, please crush the bottle and dispose.)

•How to recognize a pet bottle?

All pet bottles have a mark on the right. ⇒

•Should it be separated by color? No, it's "NOT" necessary.

Q. How should I dispose of...

Answers

Bottle caps	Please throw them away as un-burnable trash.
Labels on the pet bottle	You do not need to remove labels.
Plastic cap safety seals & handles	They can be left on the bottle.
Pet bottles containing oil or dirt	Please throw away those kinds as burnable trash.
What should I do if there is something in the pet bottles such as a cigarette butt, etc.?	<u>Remove everything from inside cans and rinse them first, then put into a recycle bin. If you cannot remove an object from the can, please throw it away as un-burnable trash.</u>

古紙類／Used Papers

Q. How should I dispose of...

Answers

Used papers	Please <u>classify the papers</u> as newspapers, magazines, carbon boxes, and paper packs, <u>and bundle each category with string; then, throw away on the used paper collection day.</u> ※When you tie up a pile of papers, you can <u>use any kind of string</u> , but <u>no gummed tapes</u> please.
Newspapers & Advertising fliers	Please separate advertising fliers from newspapers and <u>throw the fliers away with magazines.</u> It is possible to use paper bags that newsagents distribute.
Wrapping paper	Please fold the wrapping paper and throw it away by <u>tying it up with magazines.</u>
Paper boxes that contained gifts, pastries, chocolates, caramel candies, and other sweets	Crush the boxes and <u>throw them away with magazines.</u>

Milk cartons	Milk cartons <u>should be rinsed and opened out, and tied together with a string before disposing.</u>
Beverage cartons	A coating technique is used inside those, so please <u>throw away those kinds with burnable garbage.</u>
Carbon boxes that have gummed tapes and metallic objects attached	Please <u>eliminate all objects attached and throw carbon boxes away on the used paper collection day.</u>
Dirty used papers	It is okay to <u>recycle them, except if they are contaminated by paint or oil.</u>
Others: Papers with wax coating (such as paper cups), oil paper, photographs, papers coloring by applied heat, carbon papers, etc.	Please dispose of them as burnable trash.

びん類 / Glass bottles

Q. How should I dispose of...

Answers

Glass bottles, glass jars, one-cup glass bottles, whiskey or wine bottles	Please <u>remove bottle tops or crown caps from the bottles and throw these bottles away according to their color.</u> Bottle tops and crown caps should be un-burnable garbage. Caution: Don't put any bags in the recycle bin.
Smoky glass bottles	Please check the bottle color at the bottleneck, and <u>put the glass in the appropriate recycle bin according to its color.</u>
Ramune(ラムネ) soda pop bottles	Please <u>remove bottle caps & marbles, and divide the bottle according to color and throw away.</u> Bottle caps and marbles are un-burnable garbage. ※If you cannot remove a bottle cap or a marble, please dispose of the bottle with unburnable trash.
1.8 liter Sake bottles & beer bottles	If possible, please <u>return those bottles to the store.</u> Or please <u>take out the bottles to 廃品回収 (Haihin Kaishu) community collection.</u>
Salad dressing bottles & bottles containing seasonings	If you <u>cannot completely clean oiliness inside the bottles,</u> please throw away as un-burnable trash.
Cosmetic bottles & milky-white bottles	Please throw them away as un-burnable trash.

Broken glass bottles	It is very dangerous when collectors collect them. Therefore, we would appreciate it if you could <u>wrap up the broken ones, then throw them away as unburnable garbage.</u> Also, write "キケン" on the garbage bag if possible.
What should I do if there is something in the glass bottles such as a cigarette butt, etc.?	<u>Remove everything from inside bottles and rinse them first, then please put into a recycle bin according to its color.</u> If you cannot remove an object from the bottle, please throw it away as un-burnable trash.

Hakushoku Tray

白色トレイ / White Foam Trays

What is a white foam tray? **A.** It should be a tray made from foaming styrene.

Q. How should I dispose of...

Answers

White foam trays	<u>Please wash and dry trays before putting them in the collection bin to be recycled. Also you can take those trays to supermarkets which give tray-collection service.</u>
Colored & patterned trays	<u>Please remove tapes, wraps, or plastic films, from the tray, and wash and dry trays. Then you can take those trays to supermarkets which provide tray-collection bin.</u>
Instant noodle containers, lunch box trays, dirty trays	Please throw them away as burnable garbage.

粗大ごみ・リサイクル品 / Oversized Garbage & Recycle items

What is classified as...?

Oversized garbage ---- Items that cannot be carried by one person and measure less than 2m are designated. (Please ask us for more details.)

Recycle items ---- Normally usable items, except TVs, refrigerators, freezers, laundry machines, air conditioners, and personal computers. (Please ask us for more details.)

Specific items: **chests, sideboards, tables, Kotatus, desks, table & chair sets, sinks, gas stoves, bicycles, etc.**

Q. How should I apply for the disposal or recycling of oversized garbage?~

A. Please call *Haikibutsu Taisaku-ka* at 27-3961 before the designated collection day (if your area is designated on Monday, contact by Friday). On the collection day, please put the garbage out to your house, with a memo that your garbage is here.

Q. How many items can I dispose of on each oversized garbage collection day?

A. You can put out a total of three items at a one time.

Q. Will you come up to the upper floor of an apartment building and pick up oversized items?

A. No, it's impossible. Please carry items out to the first floor.

Q. How should I dispose of...

Answers

Beds	Please <u>remove springs</u> before disposing of the mattress if there is, <u>and apply for collection.</u>
Sofas	<u>If there is a spring under the seat, please remove it, and then apply for collection.</u>
Motor-bikes (125cc or less)	Please <u>completely drain fuel & engine oil</u> and <u>throw away as oversized garbage.</u>

一般家庭の園芸品 / Agricultural & Garden Waste

Q. How should I dispose of...

Answers

Saw blades & hoes	Please separate the iron portion and handles, and throw away <u>the iron portion as un-burnable trash</u> and <u>the handle (wood part) as burnable trash.</u> If it's impossible to separate them, please dispose of it as unburnable garbage.
Wheelbarrows	Please <u>apply for oversized rubbish collection.</u> (See page 7 for detail.)
Insecticide sprayer, strut, garden pot, planter	Please throw away as unburnable garbage.
Weeds	Please <u>compost weeds if possible.</u> Or please <u>remove mud and dry the weeds,</u> and put them into a designated garbage bag and dispose as burnable garbage.
Weed-killer, pesticide, insecticide containers	<u>After using all liquid or powders inside,</u> dispose of as burnable or un-burnable garbage according to its material. We <u>cannot collect it if liquid or powers are left in the container.</u> (Ask for more details.)

市で収集・処理できない物 / Items that City cannot Collect

<p>TVs, commercial refrigerators, freezers, laundry machines, air conditioner</p>	<p>With regards to <i>the household electrical items recycling law</i>, City does not collect these. <u>Please exchange the item at the store where you purchased it. Other than that, please buy a recycling ticket in the post office and contact a garbage collection company, if it's impossible to carry the item by yourself.</u> (See page 12 for more details on recycling process.)</p>
<p>Personal Computer</p>	<p>With regards to <i>the laws for natural resources</i>, <u>the City does not collect PCs. Please contact the manufacture or the sales company and ask for collection.</u> (See page 11 for PC recycle procedure.)</p>
<p>Fire extinguishers, propane gas cylinders, coal tar, mercury body temperature</p>	<p>The city cannot process these. Please contact the sales company to dispose of them.</p>
<p>Lawn mowers, fireproof strong box, metallic tire chain, battery, home tank, home pump</p>	<p>The city cannot process these. Please ask a recycling company to dispose of them.</p>
<p>Tires with wheels</p>	<p>(Tires less than 30cm in width and 75cm in diameter.) <u>Please remove wheels from the tire and throw away both parts as un-burnable trash. If it's impossible to remove the wheels, please contact tire shops or a recycling company for disposal.</u></p>
<p>Studded (spike) tires</p>	<p><u>Please pull out pins before disposing of the tire. If you cannot pull out pins, please contact tire shops or recycling company for disposal.</u></p>
<p>Motor-bikes (126cc and over)</p>	<p>The city cannot collect those, so <u>please ask shops or recycle companies for disposal.</u></p>

Personal Computer Recycling Process

1. How to apply...

- a. Apply to the manufacturer or the sales company of the computer for collecting PC.

The company cannot collect PC accessories such as printers, scanners, & word processors, PDA, etc.

(Go to the company homepage for the application window.)

2. Recycling Fee

- a. For items which “DO NOT” have PC recycling marks

Please purchase a recycling permission from the manufacturer or the sales company. Pay by post office transfer, bank transfer, credit card, at a convenience store, etc... (The transfer slip will be sent to you after your application submitted.)

- b. For items which “HAVE” PC recycling marks

You do not need to pay for a recycling permit.

3. U-pack (UPS) slip

- a. For items which “DO NOT” have PC recycling marks

The U-pack slip will be sent to you after your payment is completed.

- b. For items which “HAVE” PC recycling marks

The U-pack slip will be sent to you after your application is completed. (No payments necessary)

※Addresses and names will be stamped on the U-pack slip and sent to you.

4. Packaging

- a. Please pack the item and stick the U-pack slip on the upper-side of the package.

→You cannot send electric items without packing.

5. Home Computer

- a. When it is POSSIBLE to bring the item in to the post office...

Please pack the computer and attach the U-pack slip on, then bring to a post office nearby.

- b. When you CANNOT take the package to the post office...

Please contact the post office already printed on the slip, and tell when you would like them to collect the packaged computer from your house.

※ No transportation fee is necessary.

※ The package should be less than 30kg in weight, and 1.7m or less in the total height, diameter, and width.

Household Electrical Items Recycling Process

▶ Please ask the sales company for disposal, if possible.

① Buy a ^{Kaden Recycle-ken} 家電リサイクル券, an electric items recycling permit (a ticket), from a post office.

《 Recycling Fee for 4 major electric items 》

- TV 2,700 yen ~
- Refrigerator 4,600 yen ~
- Freezer
- Washing machine 2,400 yen ~
- Air Conditioner 3,500 yen ~

- Tax is not included
- No transfer charge is included
- Recycling cost will be different by the brand/maker, so please be sure about the maker of the item.

② Please take those items directly to the designated place below or ask a garbage collector (a collection fee will be charged) for collection.
